**Kamrooz Aram** was born 1978 in Shiraz, Iran. He has had solo exhibitions at the Massachusetts Museum of Contemporary Art, North Adams, MA; Perry Rubenstein Gallery, New York; and LAXART, Los Angeles. His work has been shown internationally at exhibitions including roundabout, the Busan Biennale; P.S.1 MoMA's *Greater New York 2005*; and the Flag Art Foundation, NY.

**Amber Brown** has exhibited internationally and in her local hometown of Baltimore. Brown is primarily known as a legendary underground graphic artist whose work and activities coincided with the emergence of a new era of extreme commercial arts in the 1950's and 60's. She is proficient in calligraphy, photography, drawing, painting, printmaking, lithography, typography, serigraphy (silk-screen printing), and bindery. She was professionally employed in the graphics department of the Enoch Pratt free library (the public library of Baltimore city) for sixty years before retiring to re-enter a career in making contemporary art. Although Brown rarely publicly exhibited her graphic art work her commissioned designs for Enoch Pratt has garnered her a cult following and was especially influential on the generation preceding what is now known as the "pictures" generation.

**John Divola** was born 1949 in Los Angeles. His solo exhibitions include Wallspace Gallery, NY; LAXART, Los Angeles; Palm Springs Museum of Art, Palm Springs; and Seibu Gallery, Tokyo. His work has been featured in various exhibitions including Museum of Contemporary Art, Los Angeles; Kunsthalle Bern, Switzerland; Getty Museum, Los Angeles; the Metropolitan Museum of Art, NY; and Whitney Museum of American Art, NY. His work is part of various public collections including the Museum of Modern Art, NY; Whitney Museum of American Art, NY; Chicago Art Institute, IL; and Centre Pompidou, Paris.

**Kota Ezawa** was born 1969 in Cologne, Germany.
